
Academic and Career Paths Project AS 1102 Advising Seminar

Research and create a 2-minute presentation introducing yourself, your visits with faculty and campus resources, and your insights and next steps. Use the cosmogram, sparkline, and PechaKucha forms to guide and structure your work.

At this point, you already have a draft of your introduction (name, origin, major) and you should have 1-2 reports on visits (notes, photos, info materials). You need to make more visits and, most crucially, connect your visits to your cosmogram, your academics to your larger life story.



Use the cosmogram to introduce and contextualize your academic/career interests with the values and interests from family, history/community, popular culture, religion, and/or street. How do your budding academic, career, and life plans align?



Use the sparkline in three ways:

- 1. to reflect on YOUR OWN trajectory: "what is/what could be";
- 2. to describe the value of each visit: "what is/what could be";
- 3. to gather visits into a coherent story: : "what is/what could be" (enhanced trajectory, refer back to cosmogram))



Use the 6x20sec Pecha Kucha form to present your findings:

Slide 1: intro Slide 2-4: visits

Side 5 and 6: insights and next steps

Use Google Slides or PPT to create presentation. Your presentation will have 6 images with little text so find/take/make images that will each accompany 2-3 sentences of text.
